

Agriculture and natural Resources

parks & forests:

Forester -works in parks and forests to manage land use and promote conservation.
Arborist-a tree doctor who keep trees healthy and strong.
park Ranger -keeps park visitors safe and protects parks with rules and regulations.
Forest Ecologist-studies the history, light, and soil requirements that trees need to grow.
Forest Worker-keeps roads and campsites clear and neat by cutting trees, clearing brush, and maintaining park facilities.
Forest Fire fighter -puts out forest fires by cutting trees, digging trenches, etc.
fish & game warden-enforces the rules of hunting and fishing by patrolling areas.



Other occupations:

fish farmer -spawns and raises fish to sell.
shell fish grower -grows and sells clams and oysters.
Landscape gardener -cuts grass, plants flowers, mulches, pulls weeds, and keeps yards neat.



Animals:

Veterinary Technologist-helps veterinarians with animals that are sick or need check ups.
Animal Caretaker-cares for animals on farms, kennels, hospitals, and labs.
Stable Attendant-cares for horses and mules by feeding and grooming them.
Animal Shelter Clerk-helps people adopt lost or stray animals.
Animal Trainer-teaches animals to obey commands, compete in shows, or perform tricks to entertain audiences.
Dog Groomer-keeps dogs looking neat, clean, and healthy.
Equestrian-rides horses at a circus, carnival, exhibition, or horse show.
animal treatment investigator-makes sure people treat animals properly and investigates people that hurt animals.



farm life:

Farm Manager-manages the farms that grow the crops and raise the animals used for food and clothing.
Agronomist-learns ways to make plants grow faster and healthier
